

## Take It: a Teaching on Healing

Inspired by a teaching by Shirley Weidenhamer at our Identity in Christ Seminar September 2, 2017.

I Peter 2:24 it says By his stripes you were healed. Past tense. God has given us healing, we have to take it. We have to appropriate this truth and TAKE IT. Say it out loud. Have no doubt and no condemnation.

Mark 11:23 & 24

23 *For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.*

24 *Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*

We need to remember that what you think and believe, will come to pass. You can accept that this is what happens in life. Reading from *The Bible Tells Me So* gives us a very easy explanation. Chapter 4 The Synchronized Life

“Whatever a person believes is directly reflected in what he confesses. What a person confesses in his innermost being is what he brings into manifestation in his life. If a person goes through life confessing that he has great need, he will definitely have the great need. If he confesses sickness, he will continue to be sick and afflicted because of the law that what one believes in the depth of his soul absolutely appears in his life. “

Proverbs 23:7 *For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he.*

See it, Believe it and it shall come to pass. God doesn't lie see Titus 1:2. He also can't give you what you already have. What he has already given you.

There are five healing realities that you can TAKE.

1. The Word. Read it, hear it and say it. Make the Word what you think about, what you confess, what you carry in your mind. Repeat the verses and your learning until these biblical realities are a natural part of you.

2. Communion. Communion is a memorial service to remind us that we have a two-part redemption. This excerpt from Rick's teaching (April 2011) makes the two parts clear.

“In the **COMMUNION** memorial, when we eat the bread, we are **reminded** of what Jesus Christ accomplished for us by his **bodily suffering**. We know that **it is not God's will for us to be sick**. It is **available** for us to **claim perfect physical wholeness** through what Jesus accomplished by his broken body. There is nothing magical about the bread we eat in the communion memorial.

Communion is a **memorial**, a **reminder** to us to **claim** the physical wholeness that is available to us **NOW**. **When we believe, we will receive.**” (#7

Communion Teaching April 2011)

3. Prayer. In James 5:16 it says that

*The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.*

We pray with our knowledge and we Speak In Tongues, which is perfect prayer. In I Thessalonians 5:17 Paul reminds us to *pray without ceasing*. We need to pray early and often.

4. New Birth. When we believe Romans 10: 9 & 10

*9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.*

*10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*

We are born again with holy spirit in us. It is a miracle. When we speak in tongues we are expressing the miracle of our new birth. When we speak in tongues we are speaking perfect prayer.

5. Gifts of Healing. You can give the gift of healing. It is done by revelation from God. How do you know? You listen, thank God for Revelation. Ask the person you are ministering to - what is going on? If God says touch the person, then touch them. Otherwise don't touch. As you listen for revelation picture the person's body, go from tip to toe and pray. When you pray out loud, claim healing with your Power of Attorney you have been given in the Name of Jesus Christ.

As a reminder, Healing may take time. The brain talks to the heart and from the heart is what people will see. (See Proverbs 23:7) God has no hands, the Power of God is in you and your hands. We need to set goals, purposes and walk out on them. We need to take action, practice ministering healing and trust God to give you revelation. TAKE IT.
